APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

The motion was made by Councilmember John Smalley and seconded by Councilmember Alton Belton to approve the agenda as written.

A vote of 4-0 in favor was taken.

BUSINESS:

- a. Owner Yao Chen of the Crab & Hibachi House at 191 West Hendricks Street has applied for a Beer and Wine License and completed all requirements.
- b. Ordinance 571 which was approved September 20, 2020, contains a provision for truck weight of 36,000 pounds in Section 11-28(a)(1). The sentence should read”and having a gross vehicular weight in excess of 26,000 pounds.”
- c. The new year requires the appointment of the Municipal Judge and City Attorney. Robert E. Knox, Jr and Jimmy D. Plunkett have both agreed to serve in their respective capacity for 2021.
- d. Kelly Evans, Executive Director of the East Georgia Housing Authority, has requested that the City adopt their Limited Access and Barring Policy. Mike Stewart explained that the policy provides for measured steps to ensure the safety and protection of residents.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

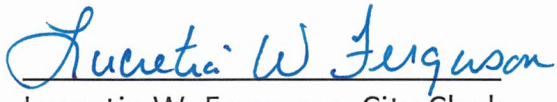
There were no discussion items from Council, Mayor or City Administrator.
