**RESOLUTION 03-2021: McDUFFIE COUNTY JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
2021-2025**

The five year plan has been approved by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs and sent back to the City of Thomson, the Town of Dearing, and McDuffie County to approve resolutions adopting the new plan. Planning and Zoning Director Chase Beggs was on hand to answer any questions. He reminded the Council that this is a continuation of the previous 2015-2020 Comprehensive Plan. A motion was made by Councilmember John Smalley to recommend the approval of the Resolution. Councilmember Scott Whittle seconded, and a vote of 5-0 passed the motion, including Councilmember Elaine Johnson by telephone.

The Mayor asked if anyone had any questions or concerns about the City's business. There was general discussion of the Archway Initiatives and SPLOST. During this time, Councilmember Elaine Johnson had to leave the meeting by telephone.
